El San Juan Hotel, Curio by Hilton, Puerto Rico

Another old-world stunner has been brought back to life at Isla Verde, one of the world's most lauded beaches. Upon entry, guests are greeted by an imposing chandelier dating back to the original 1958 structure. Under it sits a series of festive bars that immediately set the tone for a "see and be seen" party atmosphere that the hotel's former patrons—the likes of Sammy Davis, Jr., and Tony Bennett—would be proud of. New York—based design firm Jeffrey Beers International deftly brought the hotel's public spaces into the 21st century while maintaining the integrity of its original beamed ceilings and elaborate woodwork.
