Equipped with ten restaurants, two ziplines, and the nation's largest rope obstacle course, [DISTRITO T-Mobile](#) has been a veritable treasure trove of incredible dining concepts since its grand debut in August 2021. Each restaurant specializes in its own specific cuisine, but it's the exquisitely-crafted interior design that really makes each venue at DISTRITO T-Mobile shine. The vibrant blue terracotta tile at **Barullo Taberna Española** accentuates the venue's Spanish-inspired menu, the bar at **La Central** is adorned with a massive copper still to celebrate rum, and a massive Tequila Goddess mural watches over the agave-focused **Lupe Reyes**, with each individual detail carefully crafted by Jeffrey Beers International, an award-winning architecture and design studio that's collaborated with some of Puerto Rico's most luxurious hotels.
